Report unsafe work conditions or concerns

The Safety Hotline gives everyone the ability to report unsafe work conditions or behaviors. Your first step should be to alert your site supervisor of your concern **AND** call the Safety Hotline.

When reporting a concern please provide the following:

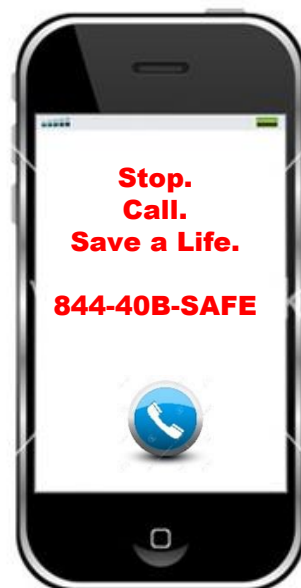
- Jobsite address
- Specific location(s) of the safety or health hazard
- Detailed description of the safety or health hazard(s)
- Your name and contact information, if you choose.

Concerns are immediately reviewed

Safety is Our #1 Core Value. Your call or email will be immediately researched and investigated by Tradesmen's Safety Department based on the information provided. Appropriate corrective actions will be taken and a final review conducted.

Anonymous and easy to use

When calling or emailing the Safety Hotline, you can feel confident that, if you chose, your identity will be confidential. There will be no negative repercussions for reporting a jobsite safety issue.
